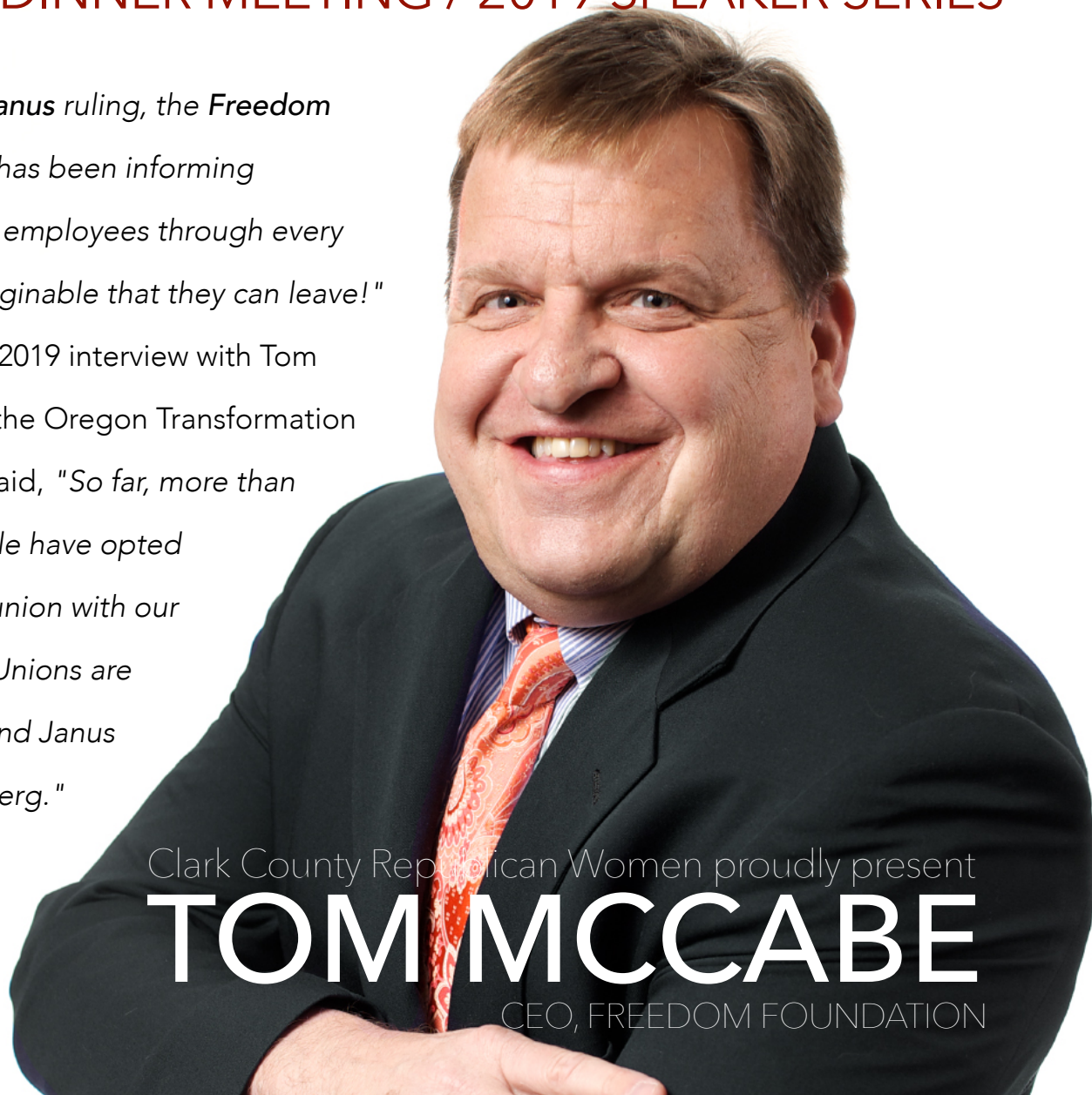


CCRW DINNER MEETING / 2019 SPEAKER SERIES

Tom's professional background includes having served in Washington, D.C. under President Reagan as Director of Congressional Affairs for the U.S. Veterans Administration, 21 years leading the Building Industry Association of Washington increasing revenue from \$400K to \$10M per year, and in 2011 receiving the American Conservative Union's Ronald Reagan Award for his years of service.
